

This tour is the ideal itinerary for the first time traveller to Croatia, or for those just wanting to visit Croatia's superb coastline and islands. Staying in superior accommodation, the tour concentrates on four idyllic locations, and also can be arranged in reverse.

Day 1: Arrival In Dubrovnik

Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. 2 overnights in a 5 star hotel in Dubrovnik.

Day 2: Dubrovnik

After breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of this beautiful city, a UNESCO Cultural Heritage site with your private local guide. Surrounded by ramparts and fortresses, this ancient town is a treasure trove of architectural and cultural masterpieces, carefully preserved over the centuries. Take a pleasant walk to the Rector's Palace, the Franciscan Monastery with its 14th century Pharmacy, as well as to the other places of interest. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Day 3: Dubrovnik To Korcula

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the port in Dubrovnik to embark on the ferry to Korcula. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in Korcula. The rest of the day is at leisure. 3 overnights in a 4 star hotel in Korcula.

Day 4: Korcula

Korcula has a legendary past, deemed by many as the birthplace of Marko Polo and before that as home to one of the Homeric heroes - Odysseus, this quaint island offers secluded little bays, unspoilt natural beauties and small towns of red-roofed houses.

Day 5: Korcula

Day free to explore Korcula and surrounds at your own pace, or take a boat to one of the nearby islands with fabulous beaches.

Day 6: Korcula To Hvar

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the port to embark on the catamaran to Hvar. Upon arrival in Hvar, you will be transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. 3 overnights at a 4 star hotel in Hvar

Day 7: Hvar

Sunny Hvar, as the slogan reads, is characterised by gentle winters, warm summers and many hours of sunshine. See how the lavender fields and the vineyards adorn the Adriatic landscape, descending gradually from pine woods to white stoned bays. Hvar is also famed for some of the very best red and white wines in all of Croatia. Enjoy a day at leisure sampling some of the local wines and dining in one of the excellent local restaurants.

Day 8: Hvar

A day at leisure in Hvar and surrounds.

Day 9: Hvar To Split

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the port to join the catamaran which will take you back to mainland Split. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in Split. The rest of the day is at leisure. 2 overnights in a 5 star hotel in Split.

Day 10: Split

Split is the biggest city in Dalmatia and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the rich cultural and monumental heritage of this 1,700-year old city on your own: view remnants of the city's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, and its contemporary attractions.

Day 11: Depart Split

After breakfast a private transfer has been arranged to take you to either Split Airport or the railway station/port.
